Program

YMCA programs include the following components: healthy snack, homework support, physical activity, arts & crafts, STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) activities, literacy, service learning, conflict resolution, and character development.

Staff

All YMCA program staff have received a minimum of 40 hours of training and have completed a drug test and a thorough background check. YMCA program ratios are 1 staff to 12 children if 4 year olds are included, 1 staff to 15 children if 5 year olds are included, and 1 staff to 20 children if all children are age 6 and up. All ratios are based on standards set by the State of Indiana.

School's Out Camp

Full day (6:30am-6:00pm) programming is offered during Fall Break, Winter Break, Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Presidents' Day, and Spring Break. A YMCA membership is not required to attend School's Out Camps. For more information on School's Out Camps, please visit indymca.org.
